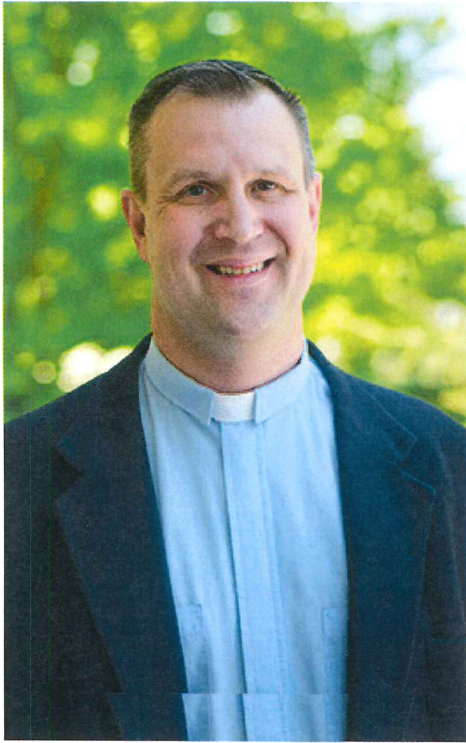

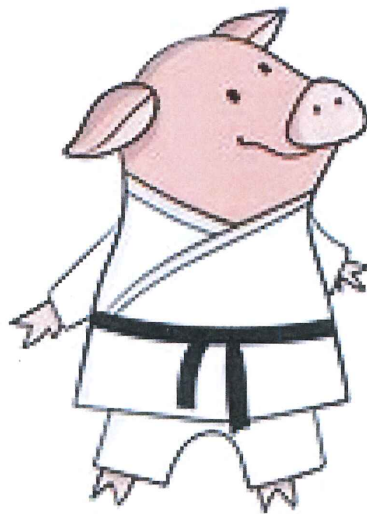

SHOPPING IN THE 1950s

It was still common in the 1950s for people to shop at different stores for their requirements, where they would be served by a shop assistant.

Self-service shopping however began to become very popular in the 1950s. Large self service stores (supermarkets) started in the USA in the 1930s. The first to open in Britain was in London in 1951.

New ways of spending arrived in the 1950s. Credit card companies such as Diner's Club and American Express started up, and Hire

Purchase (HP) agreements became widespread so that people could pay for goods in instalments.

Clothes shopping was quite a formal affair, particularly in big department stores. It was common for men to have their suits tailor made, even if they were not well off.

In the USA, shopping malls became widespread, although they were not built in Britain until the 1970s.

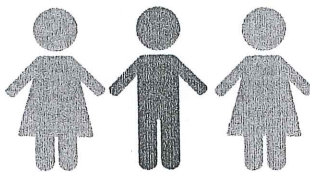
