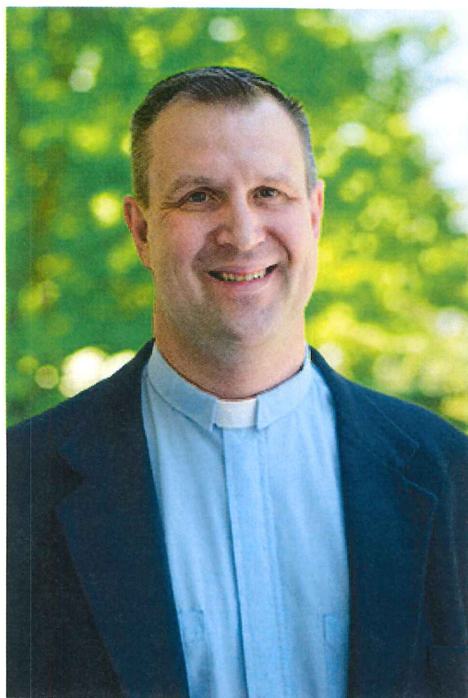

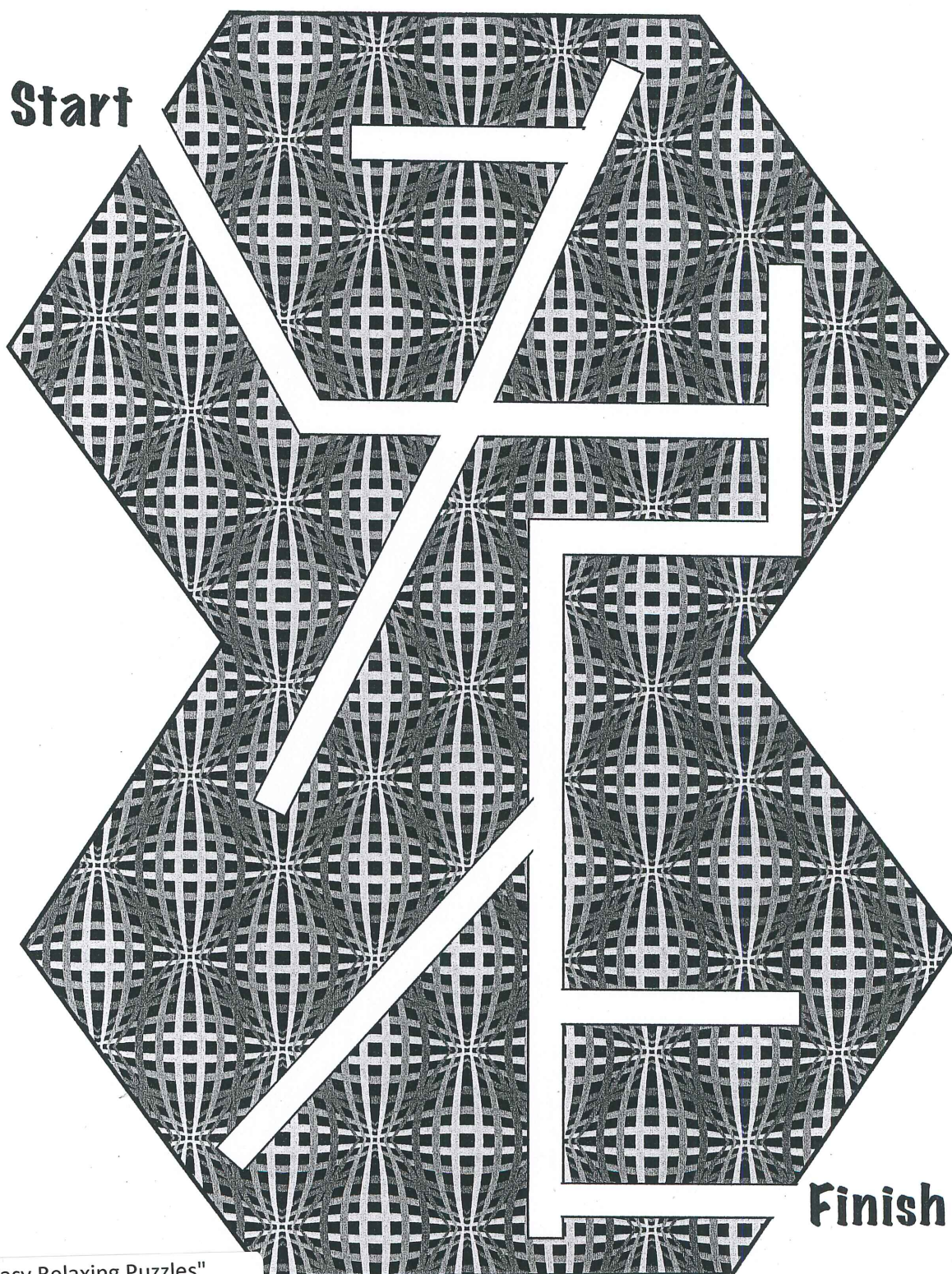

FASHION IN THE 1950s

①

People generally dressed more formally in the 1950s than they do now, but casual clothing was becoming more popular.

Women often wore brightly coloured print dresses with wide skirts. The tweed suit or the 'twinset and pearls' was also popular for more formal wear. Women often wore hats and gloves, particularly for smart occasions.

Swimwear was more revealing in the 1950s, and the bikini began to appear on beaches.

Men began to dress more casually in the 1950s, particularly in the USA. Hats were worn less often, and casual jackets or sport coats

were popular. Shirts were sometimes worn open at the neck.

Children in Britain still had to dress quite formally for school, and boys usually wore short trousers, even in winter.

Teenagers began to wear styles of their own, such as the 'Teddy Boy', mainly copied from American rock and roll stars. Jeans were popular for both young men and young women.

Women tended to have fairly short, waved or permed hair. Men usually had the 'short back and sides' style, kept in place with hair oil or cream.

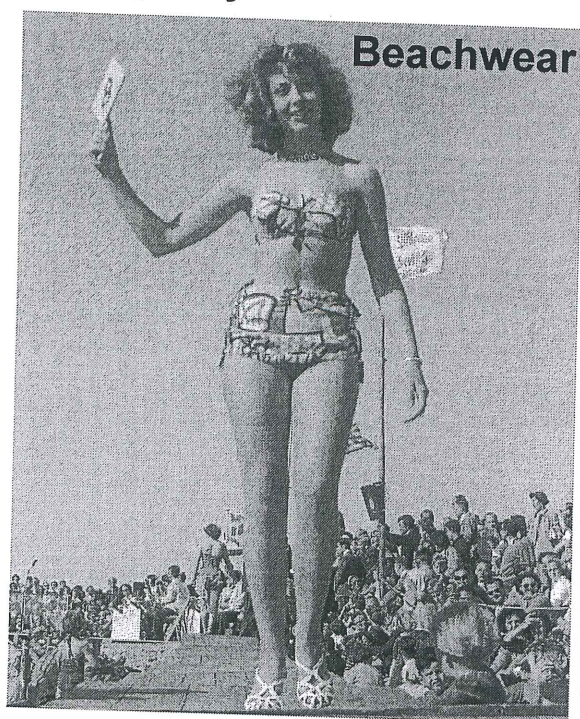

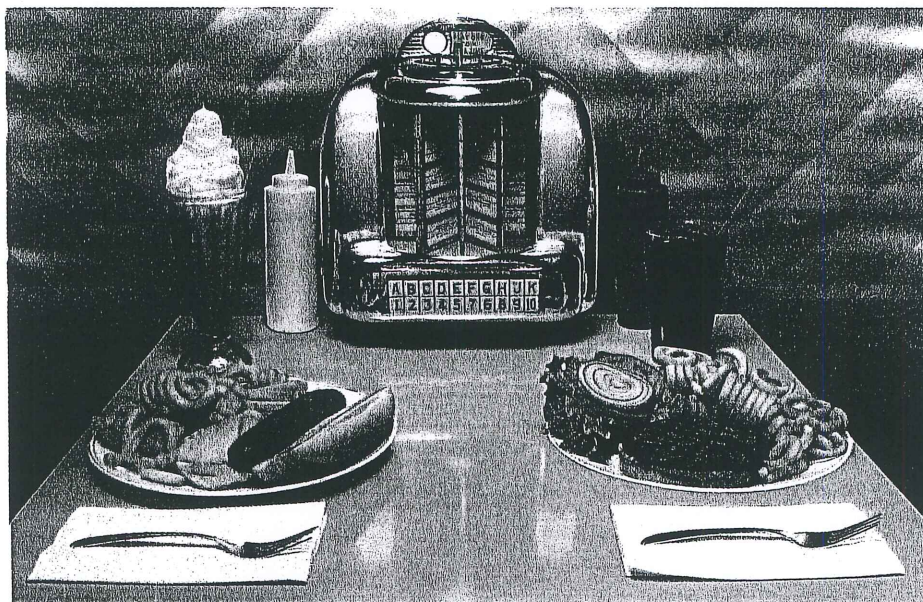
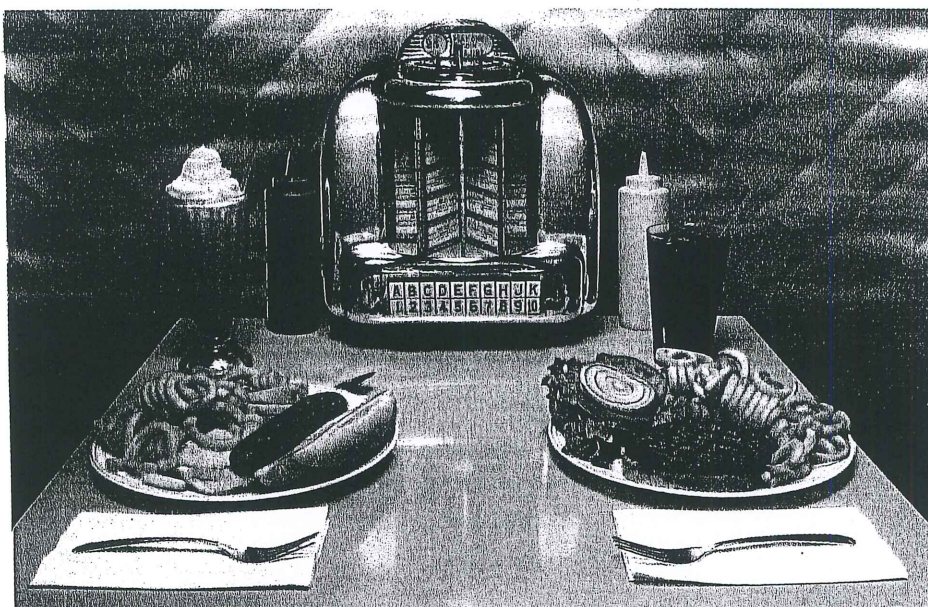
