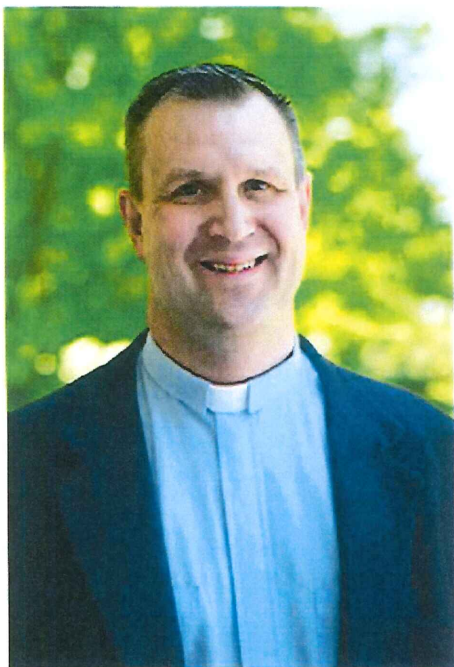

Michelle: "Why do they call them waiters when we are the ones who wait?"

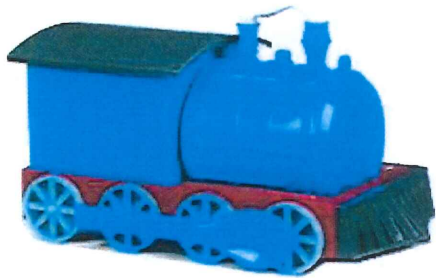
Lisa: My 4-year-old daughter – "Is that makeup so you don't look old? Cause you don't look old... your face is still straight."

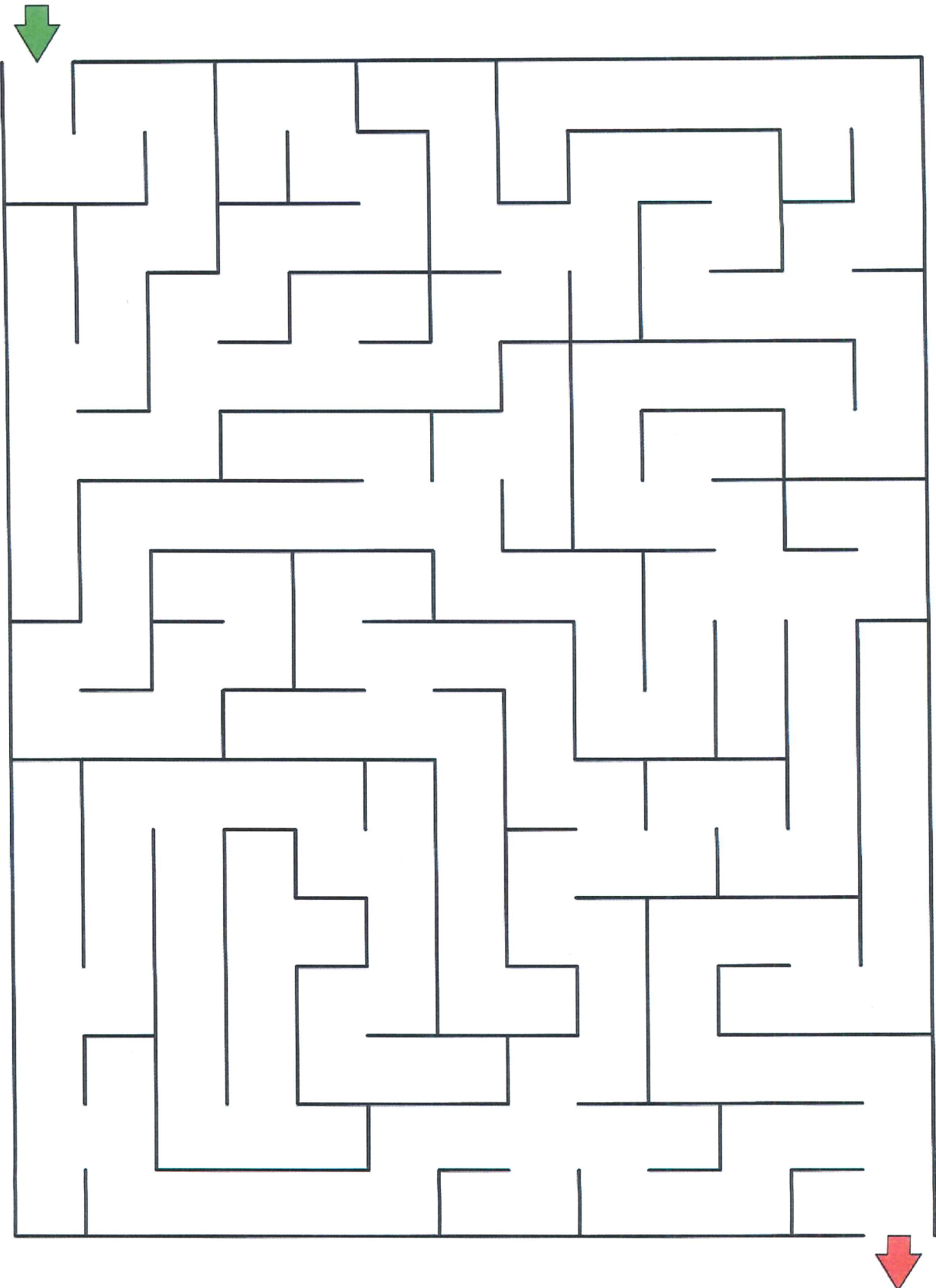

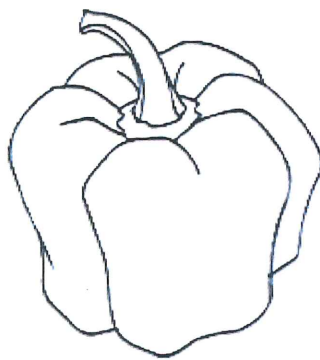

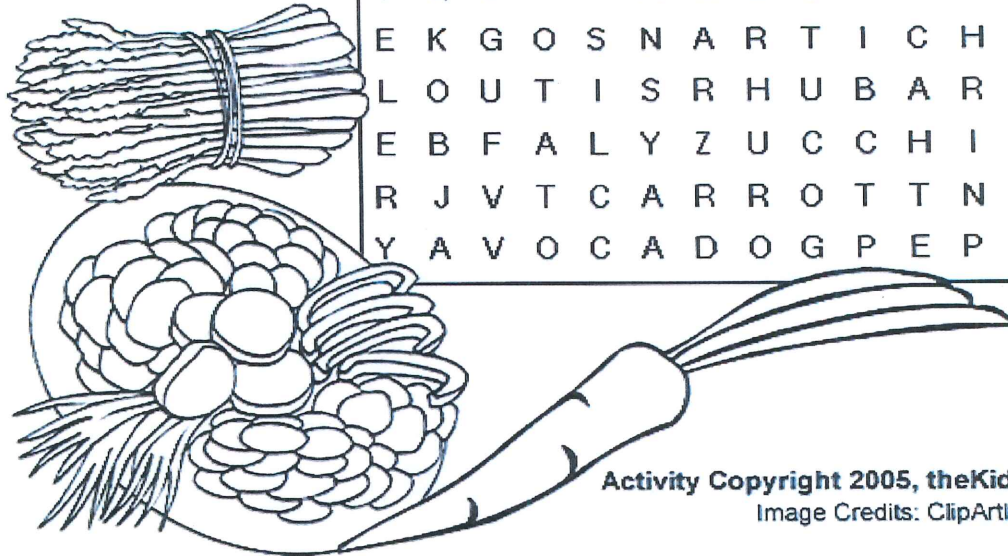
