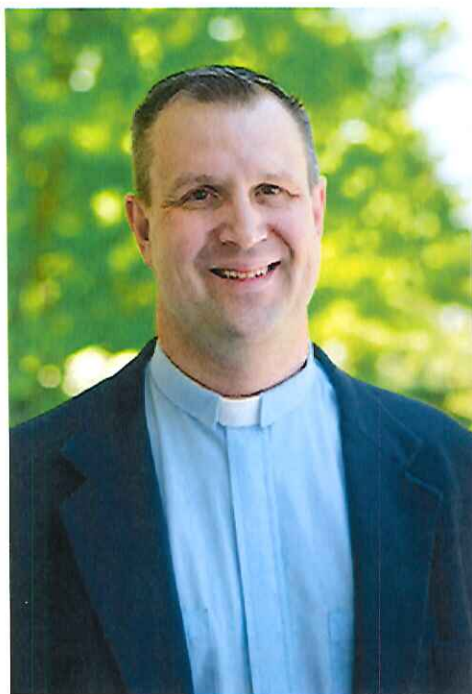

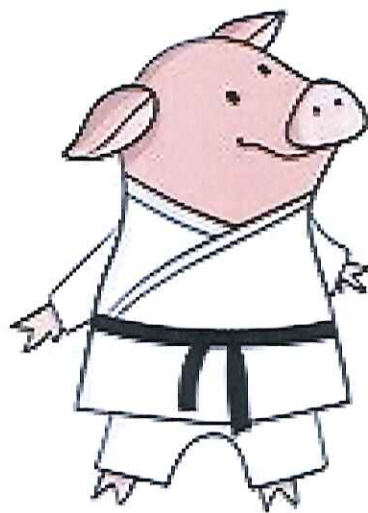

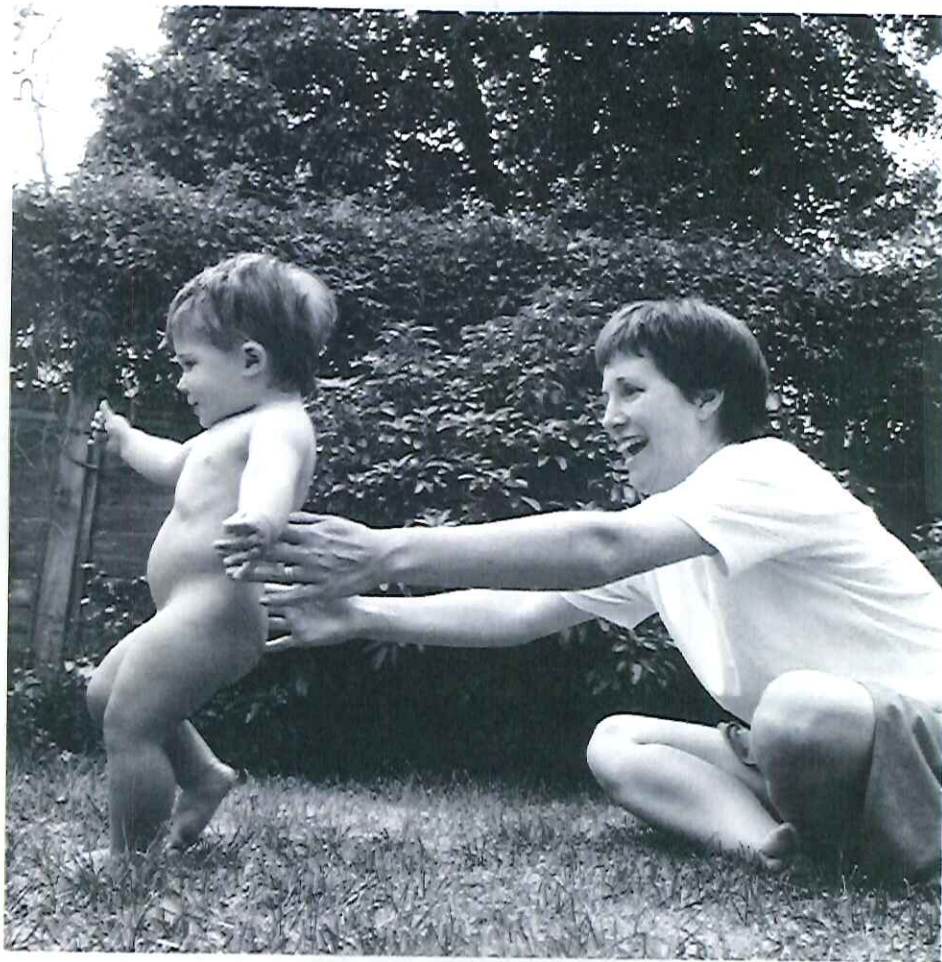

What other milestones would you remember from childhood?

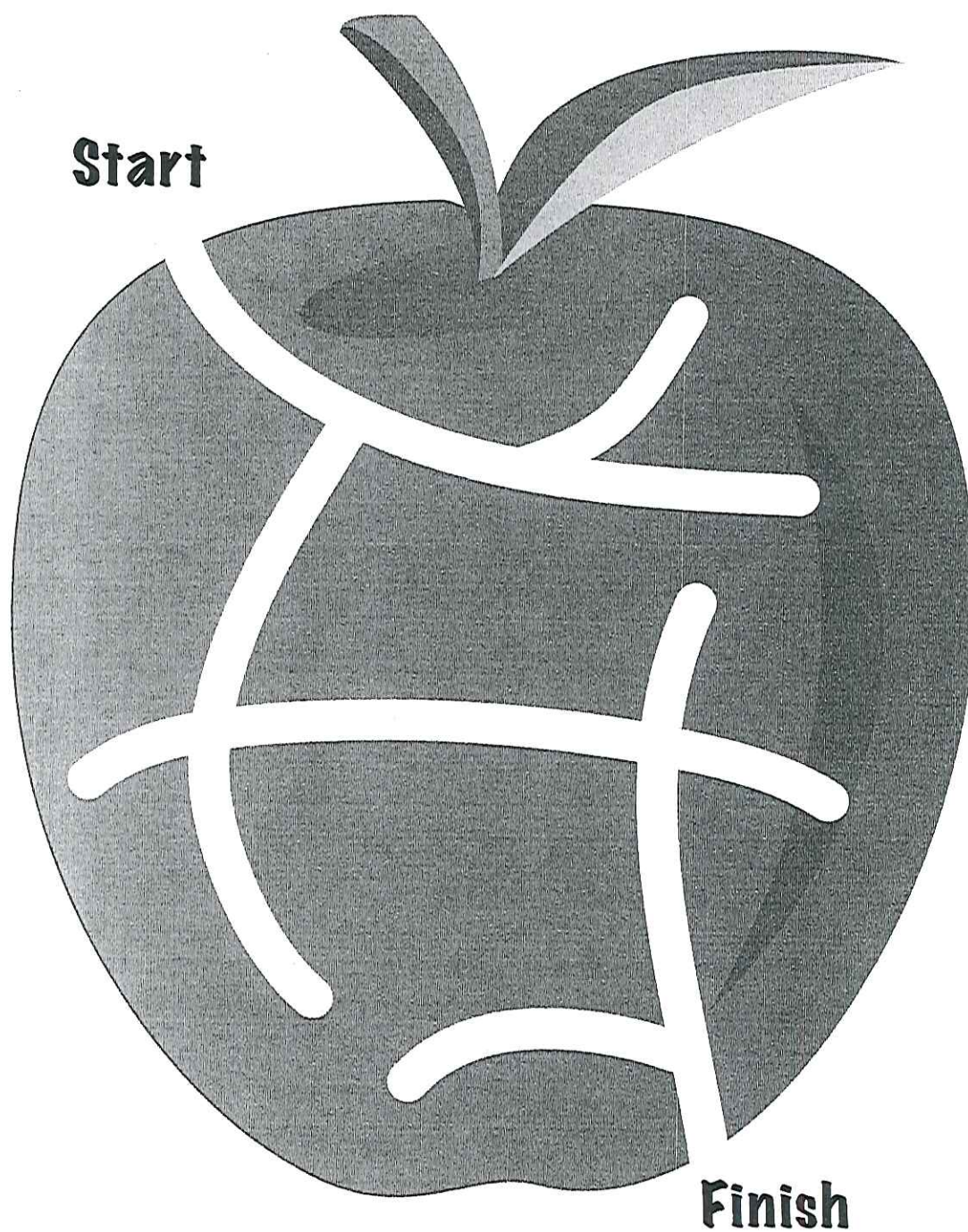
A child's first step is a huge milestone. That important moment when they turn from a baby into a toddler, discovering the world one wobbly step at a time.

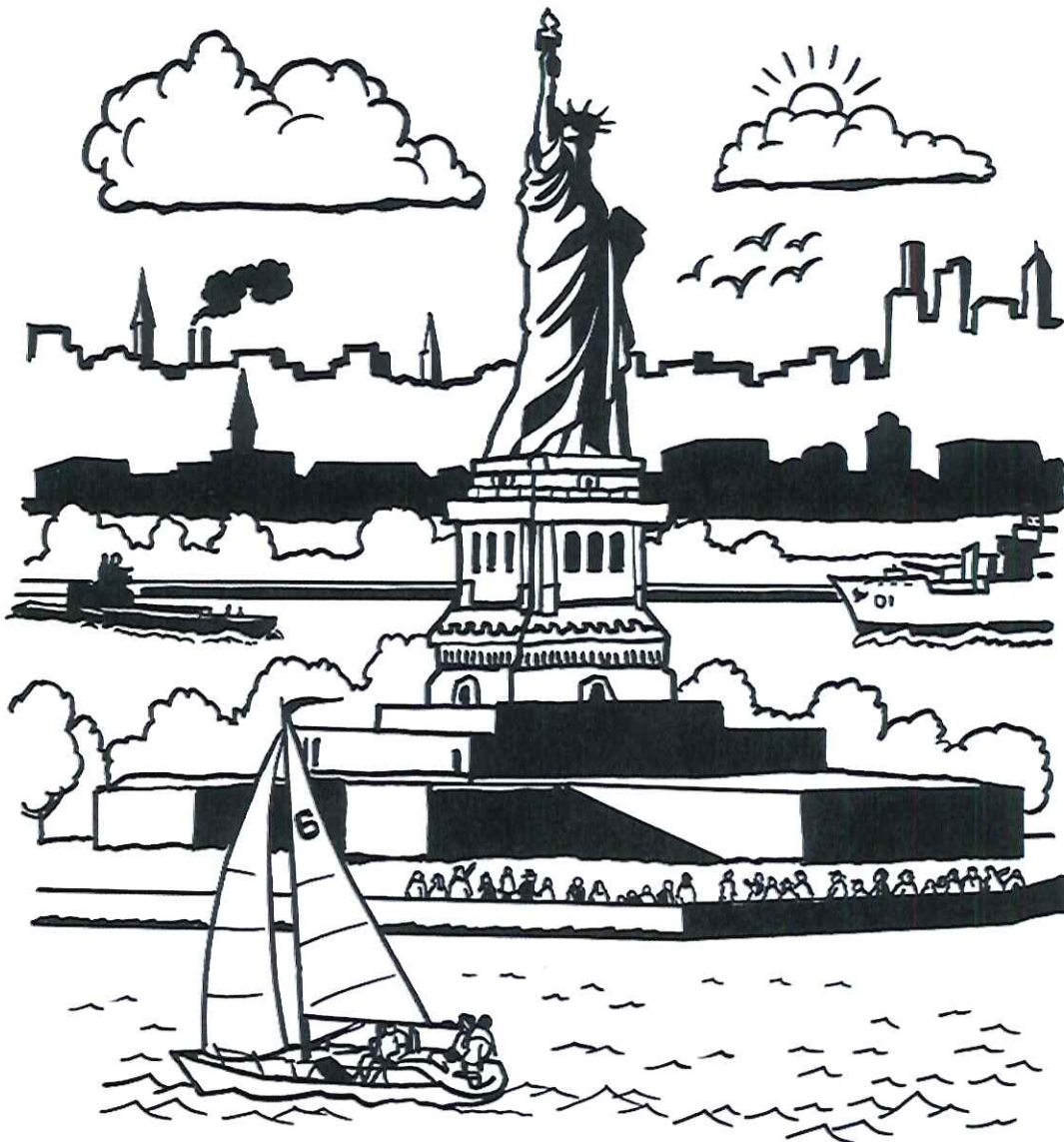

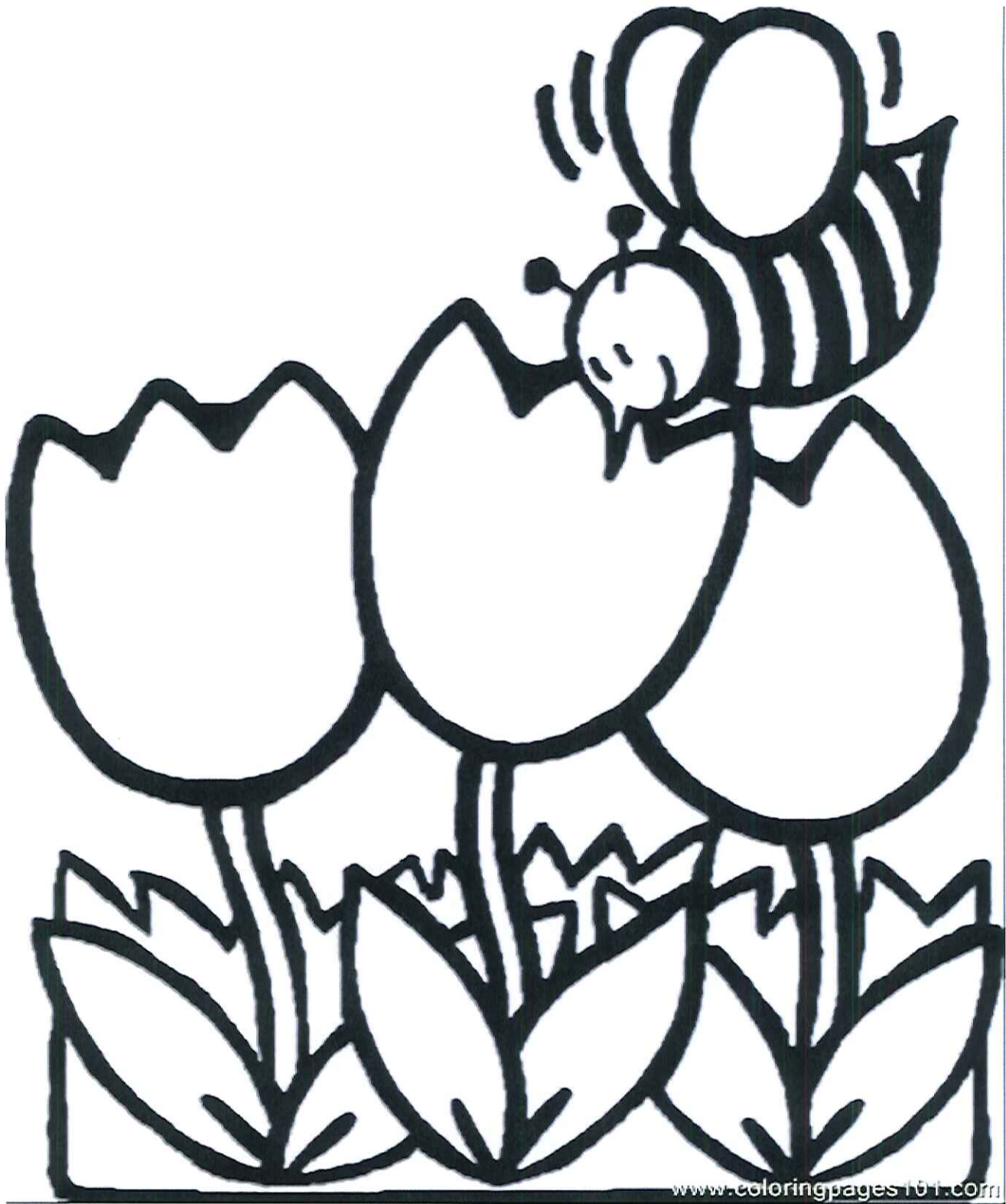
