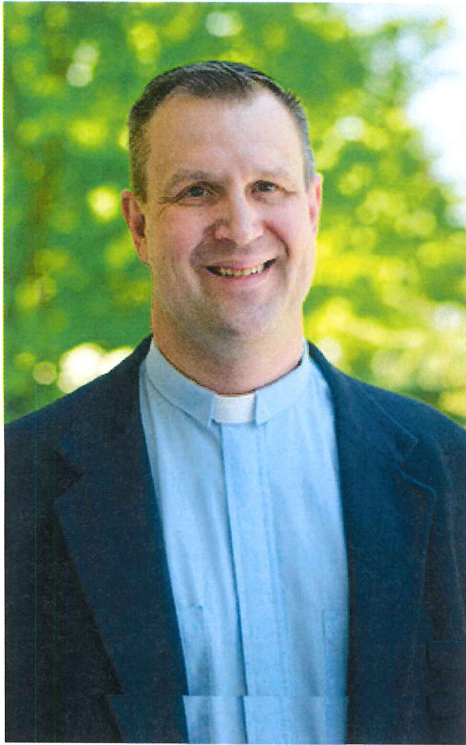

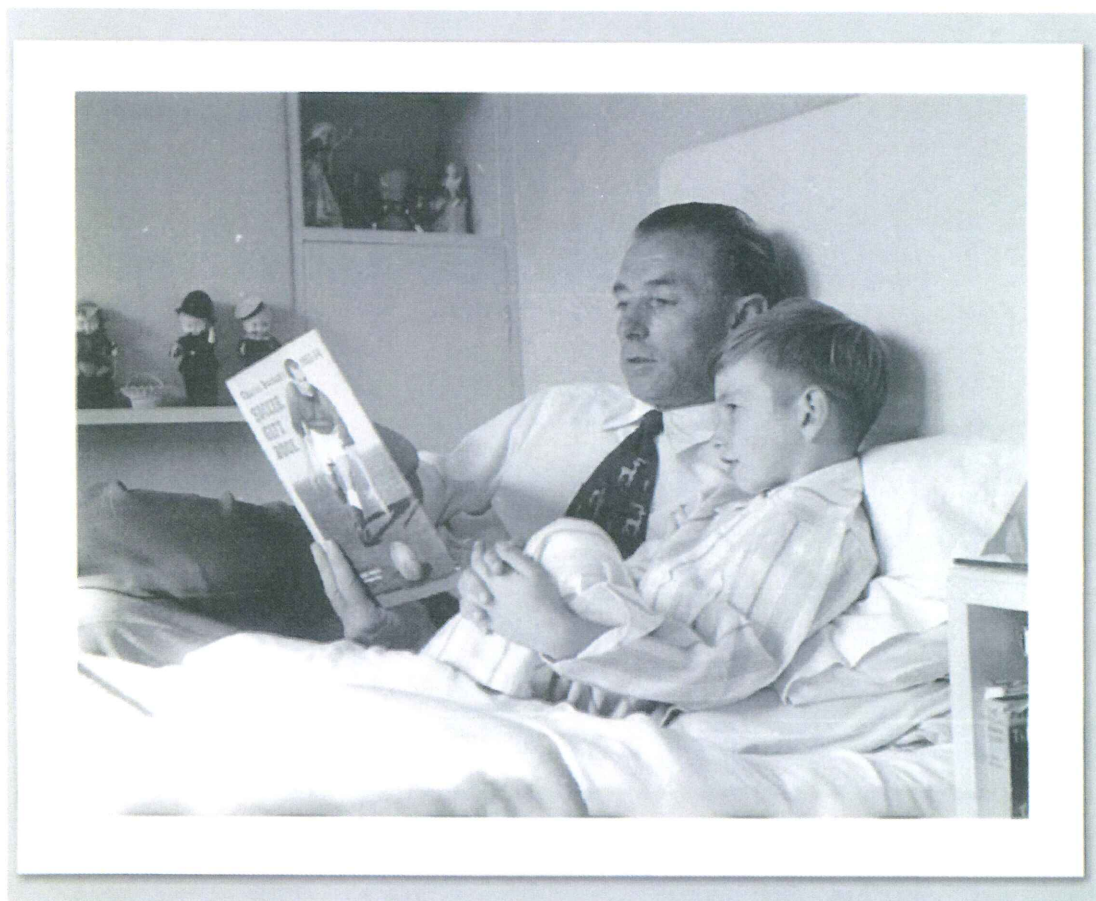

Offices were more formal than today. Most of the jobs were done by men, but many women

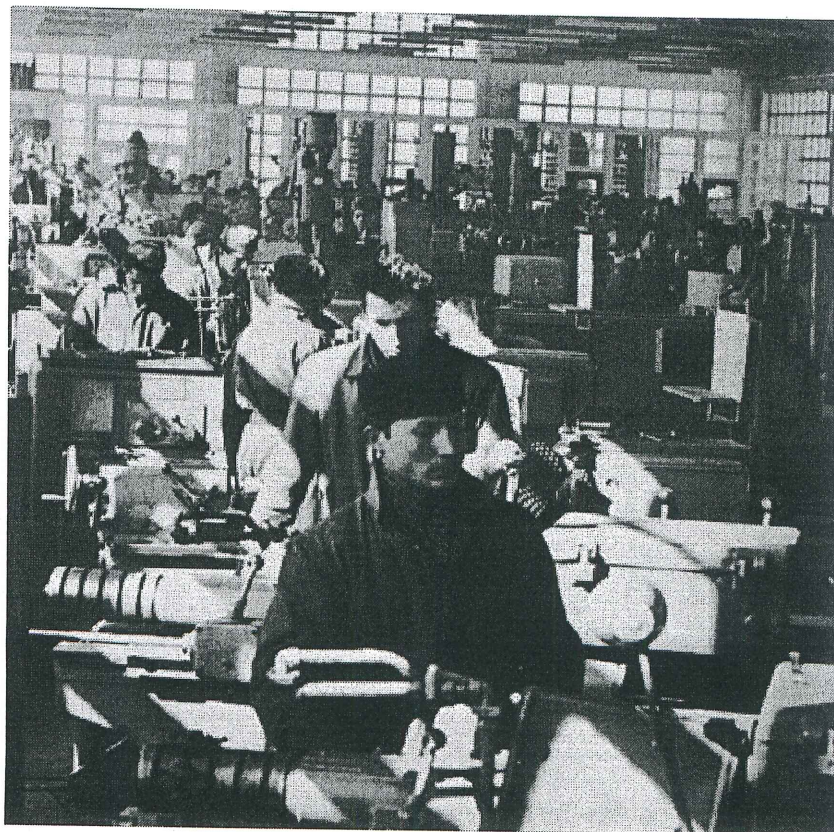
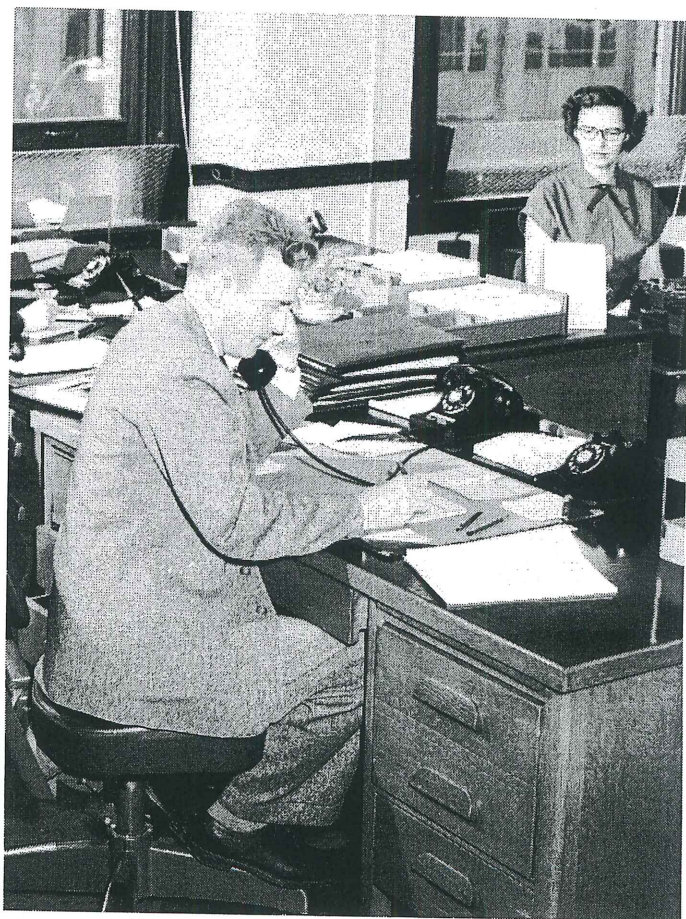
worked as secretaries or telephonists.
