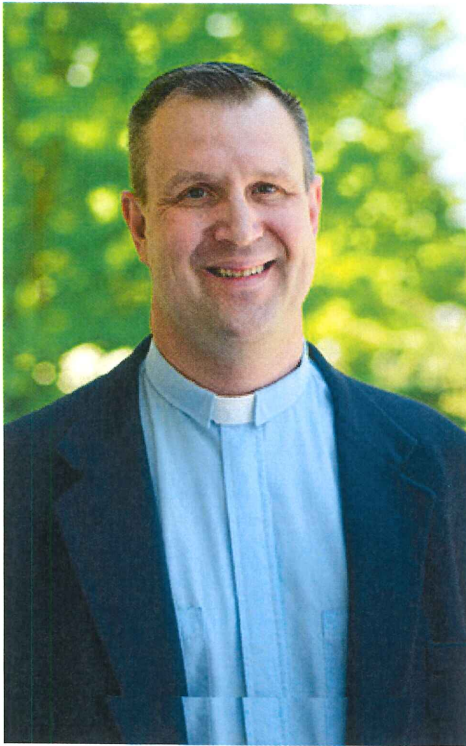

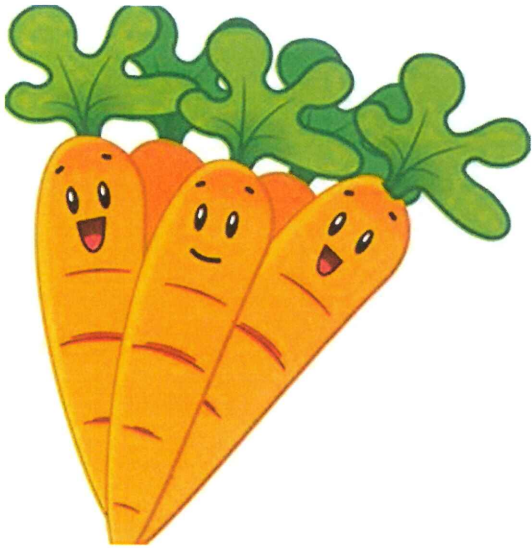

TV AND RADIO IN THE 1950s

Many people in Britain bought TV sets for the first time in 1953 to watch the Queen's Coronation on the BBC.

In 1955 ITV started and television began to become very popular, even though sets were very expensive with a small black and white screen. Children were told not to sit too close in case it ruined their eyes!

TV in the USA developed very rapidly and there were many channels to choose from. By 1958, half of all US households had a television set.

Some popular TV programmes in the 1950s in the USA were

- *I Love Lucy*
- *Gunsmoke*

- *Dragnet*
- *The Phil Silvers Show*

In Britain, viewers tuned into programmes such as:

- *Dixon of Dock Green*
- *Hancock's Half Hour*
- *Emergency Ward Ten*

Radio, or the wireless, continued to be very popular, although in the 1950s many radio serials started to be made for television instead.

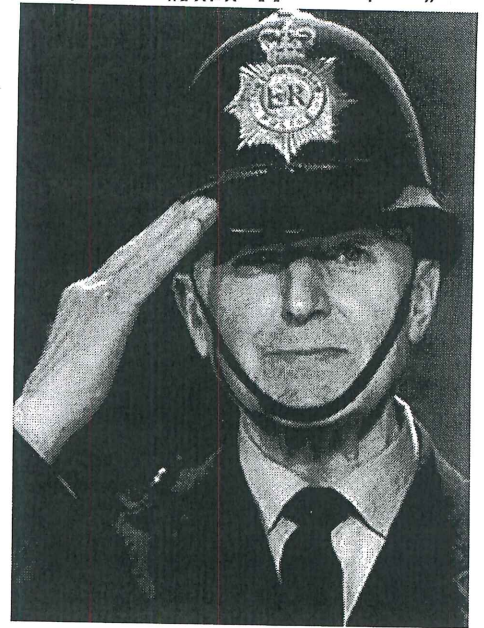
In Britain, programmes such as *The Archers*, *Paul Temple* and *Tony Hancock* had millions of listeners.

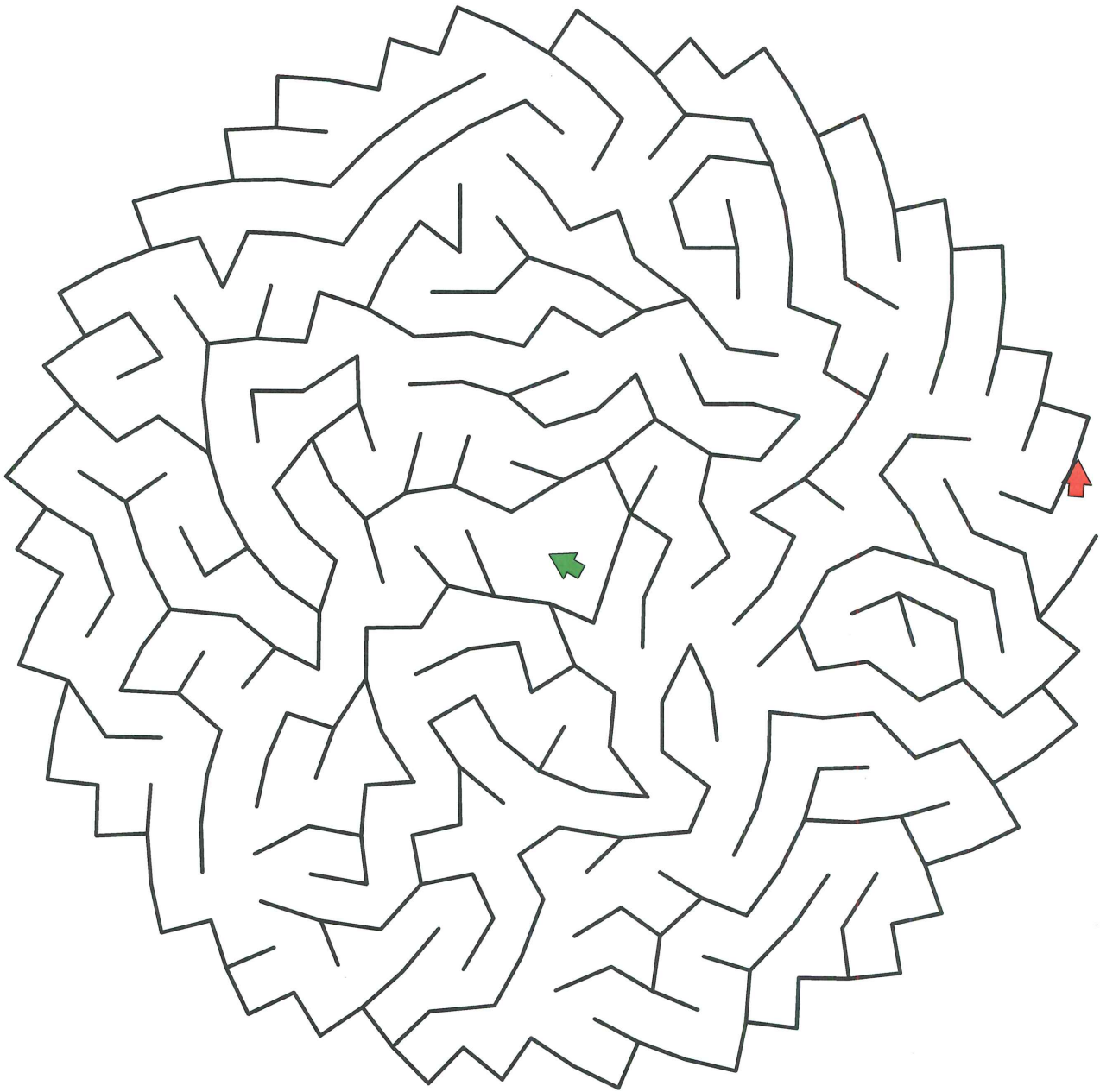
