HOLIDAYS IN THE 1950s

Foreign travel was expensive in the 1950s. Most people went on summer holidays in their own country.

In Britain, seaside resorts like Margate, Brighton and Blackpool were popular. People stayed in small bed and breakfast (B&B) hotels, or in Butlin's Holiday Camps.

Cycling and camping, or Youth Hostel holidays were especially popular with youngsters on limited incomes. Some families went on working holidays on farms, doing jobs like hop picking.

In the USA, beach holidays were also popular. Resorts like Coney Island or the Hamptons near New York drew huge crowds. People going on vacation by car often stayed at motels, such as Holiday Inn.

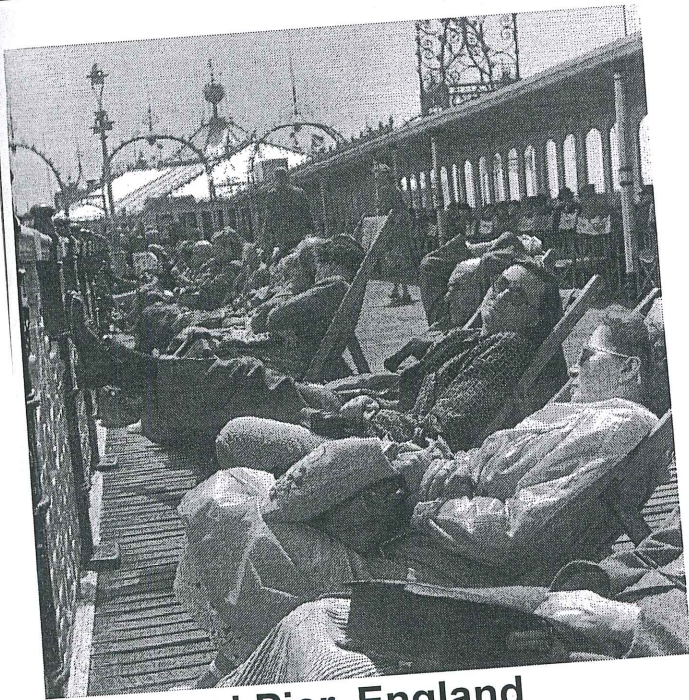
Las Vegas became a tourist hot spot, as gambling was legal there. Many American children went to summer camps. Some Americans could afford to travel further afield, to places like Cuba or Hawaii.

Do you remember an enjoyable holiday in the 1950s? Where did you go?

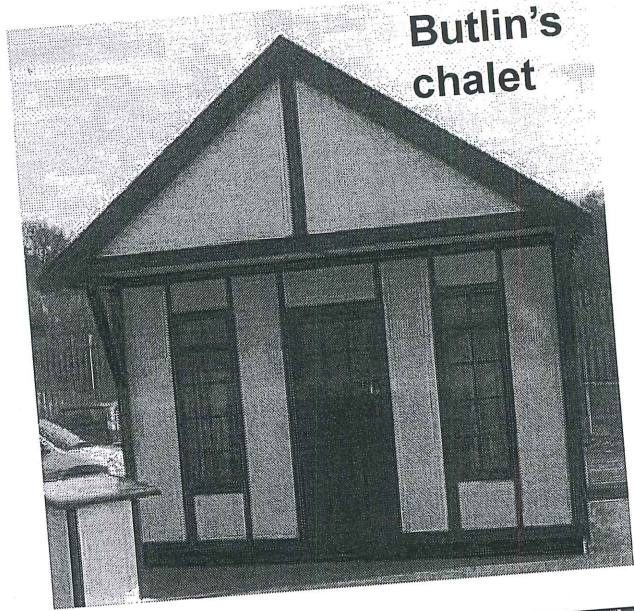

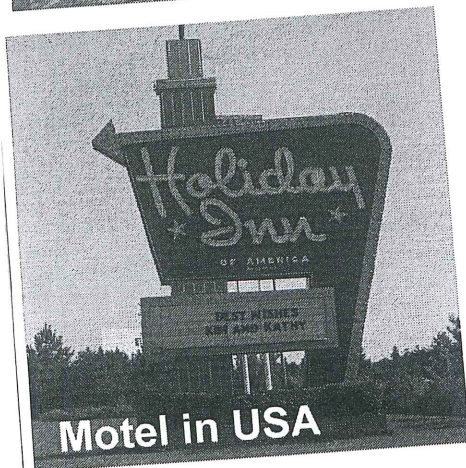

Ironing

Many hours are spent doing household chores. Traditionally there are a variety of different chores to do around the home, but washing and ironing is the biggest job – especially in a large family. To keep on top of all this laundry there are specific washing and ironing days and great pride is taken to ensure that the schedule is followed.

Chores are often divided up between the family, everyone takes a role in keeping the household running as smoothly as possible, especially as more women go to work. If a mum has a job then she still has to be on top of the household chores, whilst also juggling the demands of work.

Some men embrace the ironing, and others complain while they do it. Getting the kids to help is even harder, but the offer of pocket money for a job well done can often help.

Steam irons were a relatively new addition, created by Thomas Sears, but only really becoming widely used in the 40s and 50s, as people began to realise how much easier ironing was with steam to help.

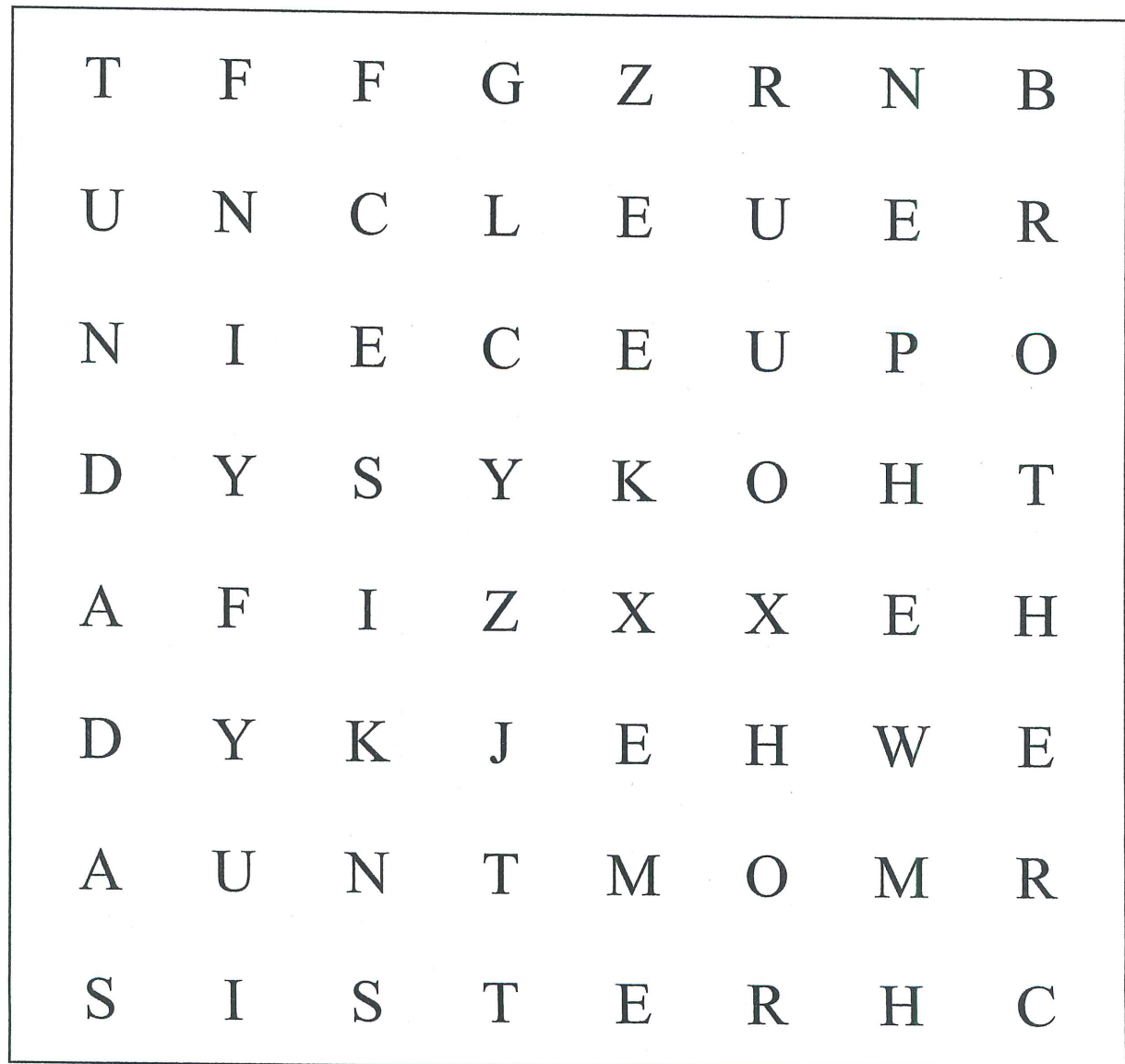

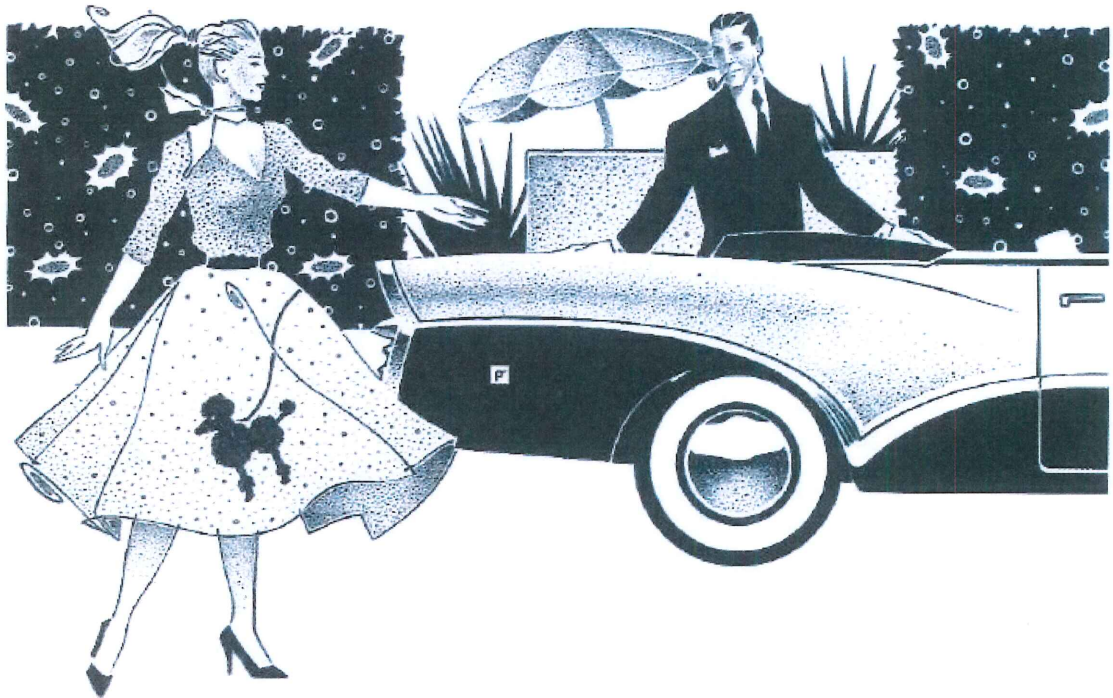

It's a Date

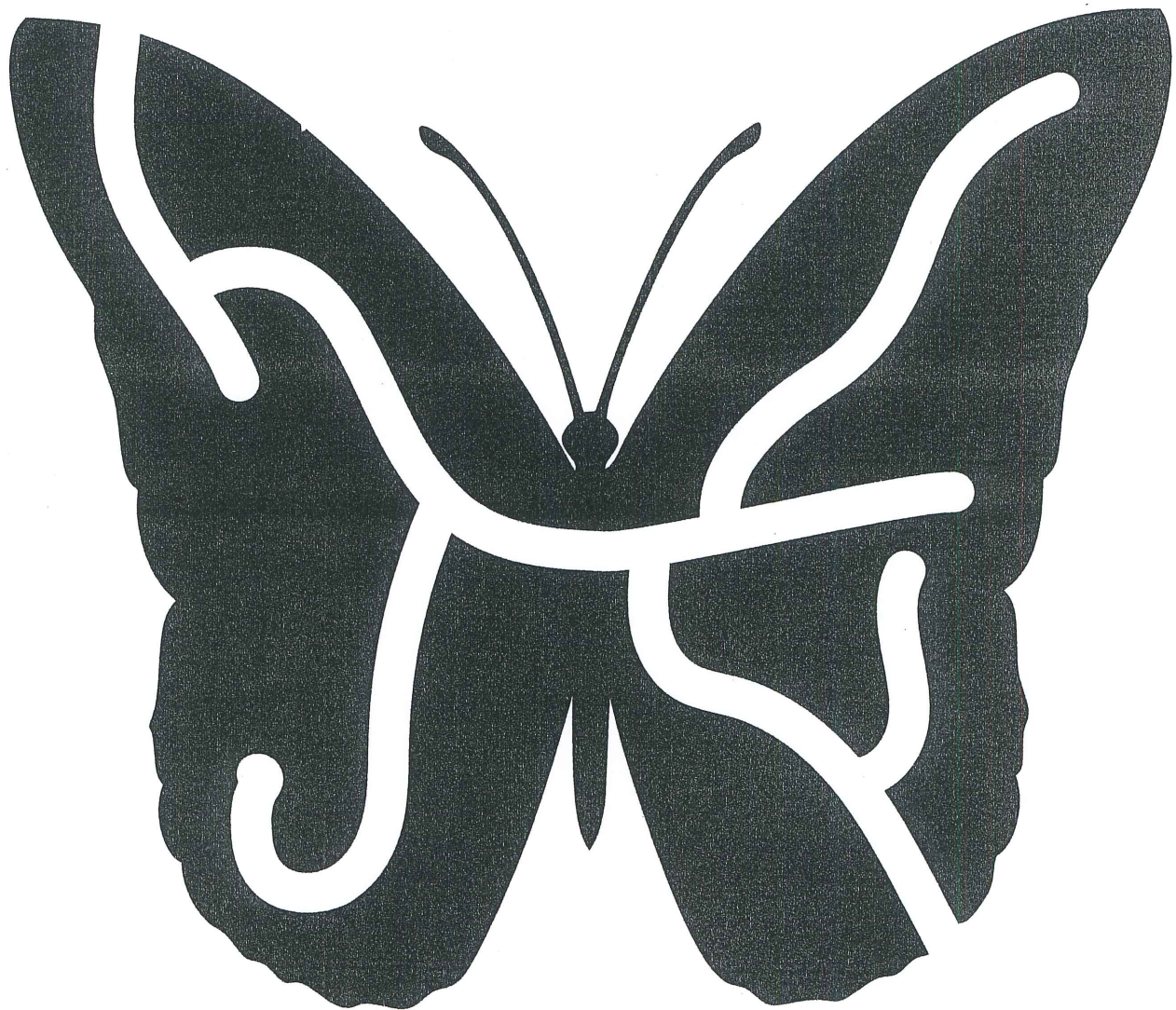

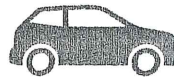
